STEPS TO A SUCCESSFUL DRIVE

How to make your drive a success

Holding a supply drive requires the dedication of some time, energy and effort to mobilizing a group. Here are the aspects of your supply drive to determine before you get started:



WHEN?

Host your supply drive for a week or longer, this allows people enough time to purchase items and drop-off. Make sure the start and end date are clearly communicated.



WHERE?

Choose a centrally located, high-traffic spot or multiple spots for donation drop-off. Post the "Supply Drive Drop-off Here" signs included in this kit.



GOAL!

Set a predetermined, obtainable goal. This is an excellent way to spark participation. Use a goal chart. Create incentives. Make it a competition.



PROMOTE!

Use social media, newsletters, email announcements, and flyers. See Communication Samples on the next page for easy posts, texts, and emails to use included in this kit.



SUPPLY DRIVE CHECKLIST

How to make sure you don't miss anything when running your drive

Holding a supply drive requires the dedication of some time, energy and effort to mobilizing a group. Here are the aspects of your supply drive to determine before you get started:

- Choose your Supply Drive location.
- Recruit a crew to help promote, collect, count, and deliver collected items.
- Select a start and end date.
- Set your collection goal, theme, and/or incentives.
- Prep your drop-off location(s) with visible signs and collection boxes/barrels.
- Promote the supply drive!
- Confirm transportation for delivery of supplies and MOWSC's availability to accept donations. MOWSC is open Monday through Friday between 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
- Continue to promote the supply drive.
- Collect and deliver supply donations to the MOWSC location.
- Share your success on social media!
- Email your crew at the beginning, middle, and end to garner excitement/take a group photo/encourage each person to purchase an extra item.




